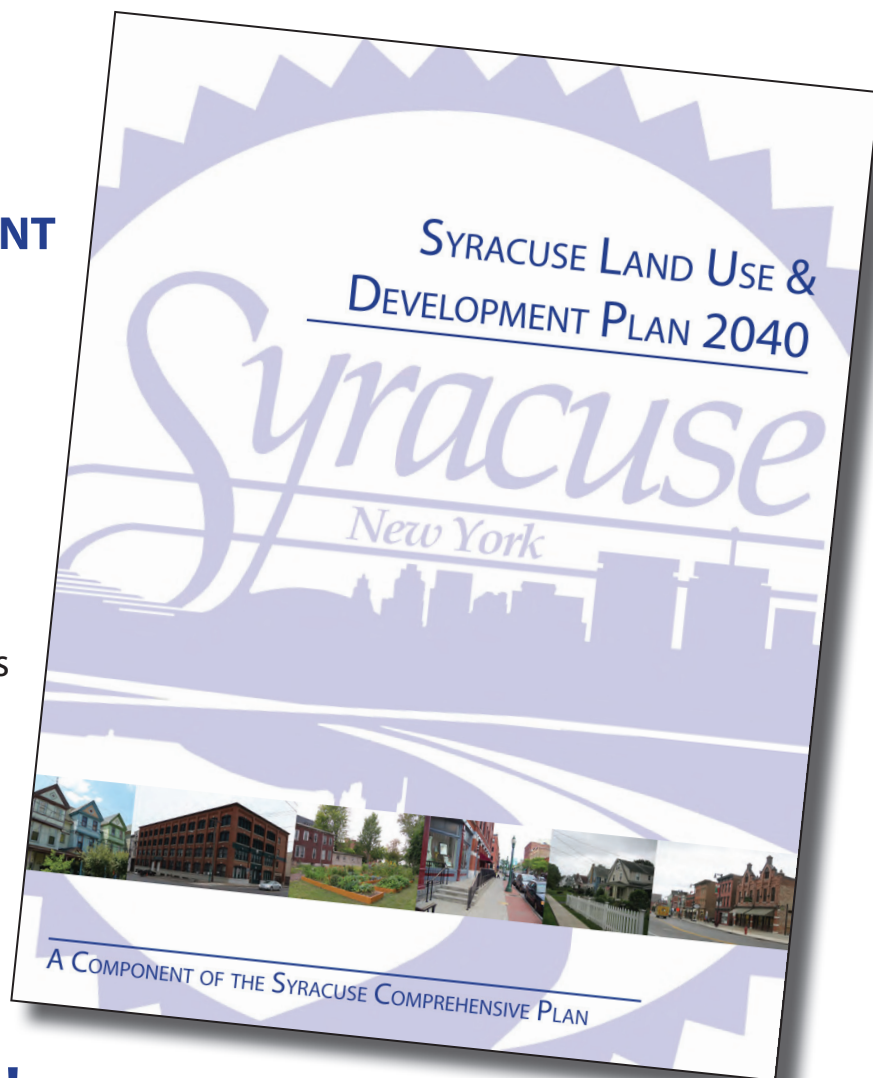


The City's Bureau of Planning & Sustainability is seeking feedback on the
